<u>Update from the Supervisor.....</u>

Representatives from the *Chemung River Greenway Trail Study* came to the Town Community Center on April 22nd to share information about their project and get feedback from Residents. It was an informative event and the Residents who attended seemed pleased to be consulted and we all learned a great deal. To provide some context, Three Rivers Development Foundation has been developing a feasibility study for the potential development of the Chemung River Greenway, a community-supported, multi-use trail connection between Steuben and Chemung Counties. This study was intended to assess benefits to health and well-being, safety, transportation, environment, public involvement, and the economy. It is expected that there will be more information to share as the project proceeds.

The Town held a spring break camp for kids ages 6-12 run by *Chemung River Friends*. Recognition of Earth Week was the theme and kids were treated to outdoor activities including hiking, games and nature projects to take home. We are delighted to be planning a summer camp again in cooperation with *River Friends* in August. Information will be available as plans are solidified.

holding activities in the park and the Grounds Keeper works hard at making sure the park is clean for all.


