Failure to license or renew a license is a violation of the Code of the Town of Elmira and NYS agriculture and Market Law. Any unlicensed dog may be seized and impounded until a license is obtained. If your dog remains unlicensed, you will be cited for violating Town Code and directed to appear in Town Court.

#### <u>Update from the Supervisor.....</u>

Board Member Ron Allison and I had the pleasure of meeting recently, with Jenn Vaughn who is Project Manager for the **Chemung River Greenway Trail Study**. Three Rivers Development Foundation has been developing a feasibility study for the potential development of the Chemung River Greenway, a community-supported, multi-use trail connection between Steuben and Chemung Counties. This study was intended to assess benefits to health and well-being, safety, transportation, environment, public involvement, and the economy. It will also identify the project area's existing conditions and best practices, as well as explore potential routes and connections. The outcome of this study will provide recommendations and an implementation strategy. This project is funded in part by a Federal grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission. We have invited Jenn and staff to do a presentation later in the month for Residents at the Town Community Center and the community is invited to attend.
